Athletic Director Jere Applebee

- Friday September 1st 7:00pm is a special "Endowment" varsity football game, it's an OSAA regulation game against Yamhill-Carlton at Garrett Field. 50% of the gates receipts go to OSAA endowment fund and GHS receives the other 50%. Coach John Wolf requested that GHS donate its 50% to a fund for Lou Gehrig Disease Research, in honor of one of his former players' Michael Lopez. Last meeting Booster club decided to donate an additional \$500 to this fund from snack shack sales.
Per Candy McNall, possible helicopter fly over "Friday Night Flights" being arranged for this game by Ch 8 news sport reporter Joe Becker . She and John Hopkins will continue to try and get confirmation.
- OSAA new leagues. Gladstone now in the Capital Conference.
- As of Athletic Registration night 275 kids registered to play on a sport team. He forecasts that by the end of the year GHS could possibly have 500-600 of the schools 790 students playing at least one sport.
- Academic Minimum Requirements: 2.0gpa and No "F"s. Applebee also advised parents to pass along to their students that violations of athletic code of conduct could lead to suspensions. This includes violations on student blogs and myspaces.

The City of Gladstone has also committed \$22,500 towards project from an urban renewal grant. If bond does not pass, project still would have to wait until June because of weather conditions.

Applebee encouraged players to come out for Football soon. Regulations require that all players practice 9 days (3 of these days w/o pads) to play in game.
