- Artificial Turf install and track resurface. 4/19/07 proposals from vendors.
- 3 main criteria to except bid
1. Ability to do work, proper installation
  2. Price- Not necessarily lowest bid
  3. References

Track will be shut down and not be open for any use May 16<sup>th</sup>-Sept 1<sup>st</sup>. Signs will be posted.

Still up for proposal: moving clock and possibly adding team rooms under stands. When complete, GHS will be 1<sup>st</sup> school in Capital Conference with turf, which will make the space profitable and desirable for outside rentals. Money from rents, could be set aside for repair work on track in 10years. Space will be lined for Football, Soccer and Track uses.

Softball and Baseball Fields will be adding lighting.
