First meeting was held to brainstorm ideas for improvements and define the scope of the committee.
Inventory of equipment was taken with condition and ownership noted.
Committee wants to:

- Standardize the pricing at all of the snack shacks
- Review the profit margins on the products sold
- Review the variety of product offered and pare down or expand food choices to include pizza and healthy alternatives
- Replace the menu boards

- Document opening and closing procedures
- Train volunteers so they are comfortable with the equipment, etc.

Some of these changes were implemented at the recent track meets and were well received.

Discussion included exploring the possibilities of adding ice machines and a gas line for the barbeque, and using the Booster aprons.
