eScrip Report- Natalie Van Hook

- Safeway Club cards can be registered on website www.escrip.com. Safeway then gives a "kick back" to the boosters based on what each registered card purchases. Last year there were 28 registered supporters earning the club \$250.00 in a 6mth period. With new registered cards received from Chautauqua, it is projected club will earn \$2000.00.
- Please register your card online, or contact a board member if you need help.
- If you are unsure of your card number- call 1-877-SAFEWAY and press 0 for an operator. It takes minutes and is very easy.
- Encouraged club members to ask grandparents, out of town relatives and neighbors if they will register cards as well.
- Money is earned by club, just for doing your regular grocery shopping.
- Ava Dieringer volunteered to help with inputting of register receipts for those who are not registered.

- For those not registered; go to your local Safeway ask for a eScrip “Back to School” receipt from Customer Service between 9/10 and 10/6. A receipt will be printed out with your total earned eScrip purchases. Turn this receipt in to the Booster Mail box in the GHS main office by 10/13. Ava will input it and club will receive funds from Safeway.
