Treasurer's Report

Report reviewed. Total in bank: \$21,900

Athletic Director's Report

Championship Committee: Restructure process continues. If interested in more information, go to the OSAA website to obtain status of work.

Press Box Expansion. Likely this expansion will take place over the summer. Will add 18 feet on each side of press box and re-design internal set up to include small video room for recording, coaches boxes, announcer box. The expansion establishes GHS as a potential site for to host state championships which leads to additional revenue for Boosters from the Snack Shack.

Dick Baker Invitational is scheduled for May 3. Nine teams will be participating and the Snack Shack will need to be open all day. Volunteers needed to help with the meet.

Future projects from bond:

- a) Athletic hallway will have trophies and Hall of Fame
- b) Main gym floor may be replaced.

Bricks: Room to place bricks without being covered.

Coaches Reports

Track – Teams doing well. Currently in “pre-league” now. Very few seniors on the team, so a young team this year. Dick Baker Invite is one of the biggest meets in the state because of the local volunteer support.

Priority Committee:

Requests:

- 1) Girls Soccer Uniforms. Current uniforms are 5 years old. \$1100 request.
Approved.
- 2) Weight Room Clock (request from March).
 - a. Idea to use as a motivator and speed up workouts
 - b. Open 96 days during the summer; 60% of the students using the Weight Room are participating in school athletics
 - c. Could be used for multiple sports.Decision: Go through Booster Club vs. Priority since the request is not directly tied to a sport. Approved through Booster Club.
- 3) Football request (request from March).
Will move forward with request.
- 4) Track Clock- Requested \$775.00. Approved.

Of note: There is \$9,000 available through Priority Committee. Much discussion about continued need for Priority vs. having Booster Club award money for requested items. No decision was reached at this time.

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Snack Shack

Still need Snack Shack Coordinator for 2010-2011.

Snack Shack sign up sent around for sign ups (most attendees were coaches and Board members)

Discussed options to re-energize the Booster Club as volunteers have significantly declined.
